

Workshop: Infusing Sustainability into Your Curriculum

Wed-Thu-Fri (3 mornings), May 15/16/17, 2024

The Office of Sustainability is pleased to support the eighth year of a faculty development program to encourage curriculum innovation. Faculty who would like to develop a new course module or a new course that engages issues of sustainability are encouraged to apply. The faculty leading the workshop this year is Nicole Roberts.

The 3-morning workshop is based on highly successful programs offered at hundreds of campuses through the Association for the Advancement of Sustainability in Higher Education (AASHE). The project is based on intellectual stimulation, opportunities to meet faculty and resource experts, pathways to actionable curriculum change, practice with pedagogical models, and tours of campus sites.

We anticipate filling up to 18 stipend-earning positions. Previous workshops filled quickly.

Expectations and Compensation: Full participation in the three-morning workshop (8:15 am to 12:30 pm each day) is expected. The workshop will be in-person at campus and uptown locations, and we plan to spend some time outdoors. The workshop deliverable is completion of a curriculum modification form and the third day of the workshop will include discussion with your workshop peers. With completion of the workshop and curriculum modification form, participants will receive a stipend of \$1000. There is no expectation of prior experience with sustainability issues in the classroom or through scholarship.
